

CAN'T GET NO SATISFACTION

ALMOST half of Australians who don't believe their strengths are well used at their workplace are planning to head for the door, according to a national survey by professional development company PDT.

A survey of 530 Australians from private sector, government and non-profit organisations has found that 27 per cent of workers believe their skills are not being used appropriately.

The survey also found that while nine out of 10 workers are engaged at work, 24 per cent are planning to leave soon or within the next 12 months.

"When people use their strengths, they feel happier," PDT managing director Paul Findlay said.
